F-1 Minimum Credit Requirement

Fall / Spring Minimum Credit Hour Requirements

Undergraduate Students

- **12+ credit hours required**
 - At least **9 credits must be in-person or hybrid**

Graduate Students

- **5+ credit hours required**
 - At least **3 credits must be in-person or hybrid**
- Students enrolled in **dissertation** and most **thesis** courses automatically meet full-time enrollment requirements.

Summer Enrollment Requirements (First or Final Semester Only)

Summer enrollment is **not required** unless it is the student's **first or final term**.

Undergraduate Students

- **6+ credit hours required**
 - At least **3 credits must be in-person or hybrid**

- **5+ credit hours required**
 - At least **3 credits must be in-person or hybrid**
